Following comments relate to the Hebgen Lake area;

1)Retain the Lionhead area as non-wilderness. Coordinate the final recommendation of the Henry's Lake mountains w/the Targhee and make them the same. Do not break this mountain range into two different designations. Wilderness designation will of course eliminate snowmobiling and adversely impact local economy (West Yellowstone). Back country designation might work but whatever happened to the old general forest zone, in other words it is ok the way it is.

2)Appears the Cabin Creek North wilderness proposal eliminates snowmobiling in Eldridge Cr. Impacts snowmobiling and local economy. Leave this area as is.

3)Cabin Creek South proposed wilderness affects lower Tepee Basin and the Red Canyon areas which are snowmobile areas.

4)The above designations will adversely affect the West Yellowstone economy. Keep these areas open to snowmobiling.

5)Taylor/Hilgard wilderness addition along Quake Lake. Why not leave this area open to some small timber sales coupled w/some prescribed fire for wildlife habitat improvement.
