I support the wilderness recommendations in Alt D of the revised draft; in addition these must be improved by adding the entire Gallatin Range - wild and roadless - and prohibiting all motorized and mechanized uses.

The forest plan must prohibit destructive fish stocking in naturally fish-less lakes!

The forest plan should reduce group-size limits of people, horses and mules such that the plan will best protect all wildernesses in the forests from harm.

The forest plan must additionally address the dual issues of human and pack animal feces contamination of the streams and lakes on the Beartooth plateau in the Absoroka-Beartooth Wilderness.
