Dear Forest Servants:

I support the wilderness recommendations in \*Alternative D\* of the Revised Draft Forest Plan. But they ought to be improved by adding the entire 230,000 wild, roadless acres of the Gallatin Range as Recommend Wilderness in the final forest plan.

The plan should ALSO prohibit all motorized and mechanized uses, and any other activities not consistent with wilderness protection, in the Recommended Wilderness areas - so as to preserve their wilderness qualities - until Congress acts on the wilderness recommendations.
