-The draft plan is short on direction for how to administer the Absaroka-Beartooth and Lee Metcalf Wildernesses.

-The plan should address the problem of human and pack animal feces contamination of lakes and streams. Please consider eliminating fish stocking as a beginning toward solution of this issue.

- Also consider closing vacant grazing allotments in the Wildernesses.

- Also consider denying trail construction or reconstruction in the currently trailless areas of the Absaroka Beartooth and Lee Metcalf Wildernesses.

I support the wilderness recommendations in Alternative D of the Revised Draft Forest Plan. BUT they must be improved by adding the entire 230,000 wild, roadless acres of the Gallatin Range as Recommend Wilderness in the final forest plan.

- The plan should prohibit all motorized and mechanized uses, and any other activities not consistent with wilderness protection until Congress acts on the wilderness recommendations.
